Synopsis:

1989. The Trade Union Solidarity changes the face of politics in Poland, the peace movement challenges old communism in East Germany, in Hungary they're tearing down the electric fence which separates them from Austria. But in Romania nothing shifts. Ceausescu is re-elected supreme leader and speaks to his people, receiving thirty-four 'spontaneous' standing ovations.

But Toma has a plan. If he can outwit the Securitate and keep his girlfriend onside, he believes he can change the world.

Casting:

Characters: around 75

Actors needed: 12 (8 men / 4 women)

The Second World could be played by a larger but probably not smaller cast than 12.

Gdansk, Bucharest, Berlin, Moscow. Offices, apartments, parks etc
